## How to Change an Account Password in WHM

This tutorial assumes you are already logged into WHM.

You may need to change an account password if the customer **LOSES** their password or for **SECURITY** reasons, but remember you can always tell a customer that they can **CHANGE THEIR OWN** password from their cPanel so you really should only need to use the WHM password modification if it's been **FORGOTTEN** and the customer cannot log in to cPanel.

Click on the **PASSWORD MODIFICATION** link.

Now select the account that needs the password changed.

Enter a **NEW PASSWORD** for the selected account in the provided box.

Remember that account passwords must be between **SIX AND EIGHT CHARACTERS LONG**, and must **START WITH A LOWER CASE LETTER** and should contain a combination of both letters and numbers.

Click the **CHANGE** button.

That's it! The password has been changed.

You now know how to change the password of any account in your WHM.
